COMPETITION INFORMATION

Presentation Teams will have the opportunity for AV checks in Wallman Hall Theatre (SSC and CC) or Library MMB (SURV) during registration on Wednesday, 6/24/2026. During the AV check, teams may review their presentation slides, audio, and tour the presentation venue. In accordance with competition RFPs, Fairmont State will provide access to electrical outlets, a projection screen, a projector, and HDMI/USB C hookups. Campus guest Wi-Fi is also available. Teams must bring any additional equipment they need.

Concrete Canoe

Please be aware that the Falcon Center Quad, where canoe displays will be held, has slightly uneven ground. We will do our best to place each team in a stable area. Canoe weigh-in, cylinder weights, and swamping will occur on the Quad.



Race day will be held at Tygart Lake State Park Marina. The lake is approximately 50 minutes away from campus, so plan accordingly for canoe drop-off starting at 6:30 AM. If any members of your concrete canoe team need transportation, please indicate this on the [PERSONAL INFORMATION FORM LINK](#). Shuttles will be running from 6:00 AM to 8:00 AM from campus to allow all participants to arrive before the start of canoe races. If participants wish to arrive earlier to help with canoe unloading, ensure to take the early shuttle. Afternoon shuttles will begin running at 4:00 PM to return to campus.

Important Safety Information: Paddlers are required for display, and all paddlers must wear a US Coast Guard-approved inherently buoyant (no inflatables) type I, II or III Personal Flotation Device (life jacket) while in a canoe during competition. Wetsuit buoyancy pads are not substitutes for Coast Guard-approved life jackets. No life jackets will be provided by Fairmont State or ASCE.

Sustainable Solutions

Teams will be required to bring their own physical posters. Fairmont State will provide easels for teams that request them. Please email FairmontASCE@fairmontstate.edu by Friday, May 29th, if your team would like to request an easel.

Tygart Lake ASCE Adventures

Sustainable Solutions teams will have access to Tygart Lake ACE Adventures on Friday, 6/26 from 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM. With twenty-five inflatables and a beachside lounge area, there is relaxing fun for everyone. All participants must wear a life jacket and complete a waiver form for entry.

UESI Surveying

Equipment practice will be held simultaneously with presentations on Thursday, 6/25. This will be located next to the Ruth Ann Musick Library, between the Engineering Technology building and Hunt Haught Hall.

Tygart Lake State Park

Field Tasks will take place at Tygart Lake State Park on Friday, 6/26. Equipment will be provided for the field tasks. All teams are required to bring their own high-visibility safety shirts/vests.

Displays will take place in the afternoon on Saturday, 6/27. Each team is responsible for bringing their physical subdivision maps to check-in on Wednesday, 6/24. Our team will then set up the topographic maps at the assigned tables in Colebank Hall. Teams are encouraged to bring their own school tablecloths for this event.

FAIRMONT STATE UNIVERSITY POLICIES

Housing Info

On-campus housing will be provided for student competitors at Fairmont State University. Traditional and suite-style residence hall options will be available.

Traditional Residence Halls

Traditional halls feature double-occupancy rooms with two students per room and community-style restrooms.

Suite-Style Residence Hall

Suite-style housing includes single and double rooms within a shared suite. Each suite houses up to four students and includes a bathroom located inside the suite for students to share.

Additional Housing Information

- All residence hall rooms include air conditioning.
- All rooms include a Twin XL bed, desk with chair, and wardrobe.
- All buildings offer community lounge areas.
- Students will be issued a key card to access the residence halls. Some rooms may also require a physical metal key.
- Any lost or unreturned keys or key cards will result in additional charges. (\$150.00 per physical key and \$20.00 per key card)
- Damages to the residence halls will not be tolerated. Damages will result in additional charges

Roommate Request Form – ONE PER TEAM

To ensure compliance with Title IX and university housing policies, room and suite assignments will be made based on the gender information provided on this form. While we will make every effort to accommodate roommate requests, all assignments must align with these requirements. We will do our best to accommodate participant's gender identity, and we encourage open communication with our team to ensure comfort for all participants. While rooms will be assigned, we will do our best to accommodate roommate requests.

Shipping and Receiving

If you are planning to ship your canoe or other competition materials (i.e. poster) please fill out the [Shipping Form](#) by May 22 to receive more information. When your canoe arrives, our Physical Plant will be responsible for offloading equipment from the shipping container. Our committee will do our best to safely transport and hold your equipment until the start of the competition. If you plan to ship your canoe and display, please mark fragile items and be mindful of how your team secures your canoe.

Please plan for adequate time on Wednesday, 6/24 to pick up your team's canoe, as there will not be time on display day.

Fairmont State University is not responsible for any damage to your equipment.

It is each school's responsibility to coordinate with their shipping company of choice and schedule the pick-up of their equipment on Monday, 6/29. Fairmont State University's Physical Plant will be available to facilitate the loading process. Teams are responsible for pre-packing and transporting their equipment to the pickup location.

TRAVEL/TRANSIT

Arrival – IMPORTANT Safety Information

If you are traveling through West Virginia, please be aware that many roads are narrow, winding, and include steep grades. While scenic, these "country roads" can present challenges, especially for larger vehicles and those hauling trailers. Drive cautiously, reduce speed on curves, and use lower gears when navigating hills.

When approaching and traveling through Fairmont and campus, please note the following:

- **Locust Avenue Access:** Locust Avenue is a narrow roadway, particularly when accommodating two-way traffic and parked vehicles. Drivers hauling trailers should use extra caution, reduce speed, and be prepared for tight clearances when turning onto campus.
- **Downtown Traffic & Turns:** The route from Exit 136 includes urban intersections and tighter turns, especially near 3rd Street and Locust Avenue. Please plan ahead, take turns wide, and be mindful of surrounding traffic.
- **Steep Grades:** Some roads leading into and around Fairmont include steep inclines and declines. Use appropriate gearing and braking techniques, especially when hauling.
- **Pedestrian Activity:** Campus will have heavy foot traffic during the event. Please drive slowly and remain alert for students and pedestrians on crosswalks and roadways.
- **Event Signage & Volunteers:** Follow posted signage and directions from volunteers upon arrival. They will assist with unloading, parking, and trailer staging.

Parking

Parking on campus will be free for all event participants and visitors.

Primary Parking: The Bryant Street Parking Garage will serve as the main parking location for participants. This garage is conveniently located near campus housing and event venues and is recommended for daily use.

Welcome Dinner Parking (Feaster Center): The Feaster Center is accessible from campus, and most participants will be able to walk. That said, Fairmont State has earned the nickname “Stairmont State” for a reason. For those who may prefer to avoid the hills or need easier access, driving is absolutely an option. Parking will be available at the football field parking lot, located adjacent to the venue.

General Notes:

Please follow posted signage and directions from volunteers upon arrival.

Some areas of campus may be restricted or reserved for event operations, unloading, or trailer staging.

Allow extra time when traveling between locations, especially during peak event times.

Travel to Fairmont State University

Getting here is easy. (Though you may find that it's harder to leave!)

Follow the directions below to reach our campus.

When Driving I-79 South

- Take I-79 Exit 136 toward Downtown Fairmont / Gateway Connector.
- Follow the Fairmont Gateway Connector toward downtown Fairmont.
- Turn left onto 3rd Street.
- Continue on 3rd Street and cross the bridge over the Monongahela River.
- Turn left onto Locust Avenue.
- Continue on Locust Avenue toward Fairmont State University.
 - **Passenger Vehicles:** Turn right onto Bryant Street at the campus entrance.
 - **Truck/Trailers:** Pass Bryant Street Entrance and enter gravel lot to the left for truck and trailer parking.

When Driving I-79 from Whitehall/South Fairmont

- I-79 South to Exit 132 (South Fairmont Exit). At light, turn onto Route 250 North.
- Follow 250 North and at 2nd light turn left onto Country Club Road.
- At 1st light, turn right onto Locust Avenue.
- At 3rd light, turn left at the main entrance to campus and proceed up hill to parking.

Located in Latrobe, PA, open 9 am - 4 pm on Monday - Friday and 12 pm - 4 pm on Saturday

Located in Parkersburg, WV, open 7 am - 5:30 pm Monday - Friday, 9 am - 12 pm on Saturday, and 4:30 pm - 6 pm on Sunday

NOTE: Please note that transit systems and rideshare services such as Uber and Lyft are limited in West Virginia due to geographic constraints and will not be consistently available in the Fairmont area. Participants are encouraged to complete the shuttle information in the Personal Information Form to indicate a need for transit assistance, or to plan transportation arrangements in advance whenever possible.



Tygart Lake State Park Travel

Input Tygart Lake Marina into GPS. This should bring you into Tygart Lake State Park via Boyce Road. Trucks and trailers MUST enter this way. Simply entering Tygart Lake State Park will sometimes route drivers in via Parkview Road. This route is not appropriate for trailers or significant event traffic. Signage will be posted on the day of the event.

AGAIN, do not rely blindly on GPS, as it may route you to Parkview Road, which is not suitable for trailers or event traffic. Enter the park via Boyce Road.

Shuttles will be running from 6:00 AM to 8:00 AM from campus, to allow all participants to arrive before the start of canoe races. If participants wish to arrive earlier to help with canoe unloading, ensure to take the early shuttle.
