# Symposium 2026 Competitions (ASS)



#### **Concrete Canoe**

This competition designs and builds a full scale canoe to be used in various races. It also showcases students' design skills and innovative processes. Constructed canoes will race in Mosquito Lake to test the prototypes!



### Steel Bridge



This competition features a steel bridge designed and constructed by a team of university students. Students must design and fabricate a bridge that can be assembled the quickest and withstand various loading tests. Scoring is a combination of construction time, cost efficiency, and bridge strength!

#### Surveying

This competition requires surveying teams to take part in various field tasks to test their speed and accuracy and map out a designated site. Most accurate survey wins the competition!



#### **Water Treatment**



The Water Treatment Competition includes the research, design, presentation, and hands-on construction of a filter made from supplies commonly found in homes/businesses. Students must collaborate in order to apply wastewater treatment principles and provide a solution for a realworld situation.

#### **Sustainable Solutions**

The ASCE Sustainable Solutions Competition challenges students to develop a stronger understanding of sustainability and learn to incorporate sustainable solutions into everyday problems that engineers may encounter. Students are encouraged to be creative in their solutions and use all resources available.



### **Timber Strong**



The Timber Strong Competition seeks teams to design and build a 2-story wood light-framed building that is sustainable, aesthetically pleasing, and structurally durable.
