

Scavenger Hunt

Section 1: Objective

1.1 Welcome to our exciting scavenger hunt and tour of the university campus! You're about to embark on an adventure that will not only help you discover the hidden treasures of our campus but also give you a feel for what it's like to be a part of the Tarleton State community. As you make your way through various clues and challenges, you'll get a chance to explore key landmarks, lecture halls, and meet some of the friendly faces that make our university such a special place. A map of Tarleton State University will be provided to complete the challenge.

Section 2: Team Size

- 2.1 A team must consist of no more than five (5) students from a university in good standing with their respective ASCE Section and ASCE Global. All team members must be registered attendees of the symposium for all days on which the Scavenger Hunt will take place.
- 2.2 Each team must have one (1) Team Captain.

Section 3: Team Limits

3.1 Each university may have one (1) team.

Section 4: Rules

- 4.1 **Follow the Clues:** Each clue will lead you to a specific location on campus. Different clues are worth different points ranging from 1-3 points.
- 4.2 **Take Photos:** At each stop, take a picture with at least one member of your team at the location. You will be submitting these pictures to get the points.
- 4.3 **Be Respectful:** Remember, you're part of a university community. Be respectful to other students, faculty, and staff while you're exploring.
- 4.4 **Have Fun and Stay Safe:** Don't rush too much—enjoy the experience! Stay safe while navigating the campus, and if you need help or are unsure about anything, don't hesitate to ask a staff member or volunteer for assistance.
- 4.5 **Completion:** Your entire team must be back at check in by 4:00pm. Additional information on how the photos will be shared with the judges will be provided prior to the event.



Section 5: Behavior

- 5.1 Ethics, professionalism, civility, and respect are the cornerstone of every successful competition, and ASCE expects professional conduct from all participants. ASCE enforces high standards to preserve the quality of this competition and improve the quality of future competitions.
- 5.2 The judges may take disciplinary action, including warnings, point deductions, or disqualification of a team or entry for inappropriate use of materials, language, alcohol, uncooperativeness, general unprofessional or unethical behavior, dangerous or reckless behavior, threatening and/or abusive behavior toward an event official or other participant, of team members or persons associated with a team.
- 5.3 Team Captains will be responsible for policing the behavior of their team members.
- 5.4 Cheating will not be tolerated. Any team caught cheating will be disqualified from the competition.
