ASCE is still accepting Statement of Intent Forms for Society Competitions!	Statement of Intent & Acknowledgment of Eligibility Requirements Form are due from each team intending to compete in a Society-wide Competition - Concrete Canoe and Sustainable Solutions.  One form is required for each competition and must be filled out by the team captain and faculty advisor. The online form* must be completed by the team captain and faculty advisor(s). Each entity will submit a separate form.  * Concrete Canoe forms can be found in the 2025 ASCE Concrete Canoe Request for Proposal Rules. Concrete Canoe forms submitted after December 20, 2024, at 5:00 pm Eastern will be considered late submissions and subject to deduction.  There is still time to complete a Statement of Intent Form to compete in an ASCE Society Competition!

**ASCE Concrete Canoe Competition** – A modified version of this competition will take place at the 2025 Greater China Student Symposium. It includes completing technical portions of the competition - submitting the technical proposal and making a presentation. If three or more student chapters compete, the winning team, if <u>eligibility requirements</u> are met, will be invited to the Concrete Canoe Society-wide Competition Finals with the expectation that they will bring a full-scale prototype and display with them to present at the finals.

Next Step – If you are competing in the Concrete Canoe Competition at the 2025 Greater China Student Symposium, the Research and Development Schedule, Letter of Intent, and RFQ Pre-Qualification Form, by the was due December 20, 2024, 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time. Submissions after this deadline will be accepted but will be subject to deductions. Teams will note that this date is past the original due date of November 1, 2024, 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time in the rules. Teams will not receive a deduction for submitting after the November 1st deadline but will receive a deduction for submittals after the deadline above. Please visit the 2025 ASCE Concrete Canoe Request for Proposal Rules to access the required forms and submission information.

**ASCE Sustainable Solutions Competition** – The winning team, if <u>eligibility requirements</u> are met and there is a clear, good-faith effort toward a quality submission, will be invited to the Sustainable Solutions Society-wide Competition Finals.

Next Step – If you are competing in the Sustainable Solutions Competition at the 2025 Greater China Student Symposium, the online intent form (https://asceforms.wufoo.com/forms/wyeu96h0sq4l2a/), was December 20, 2024, by 5:00 p.m., Eastern Time. Submissions after this deadline will be accepted. Teams will note that this date is past the original due date of November 1, 2024, 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time in the rules. The intent form must be completed by the team captain and faculty advisor(s). A separate form needs to be submitted by each of these individuals.





### **Business Meeting** (*Eligibility Requirement*)

The Business Meeting is tentatively scheduled to take place on April 19, 2025. Watch for the draft business meeting agenda that will be distributed via email to student chapters for review before the symposium.

The business meeting is the annual meeting for the Student Conference Board of Delegates. The Board of Delegates consists of two student delegates (preferably a senior or junior in an ASCE leadership position and a sophomore in or aspiring to an ASCE leadership position) and the faculty advisor from each student chapter.

The draft agenda will include unresolved discussion topics from the 2024 Business Meeting, the future host rotation, new business, the discussion and finalization of the Conference Policy and Procedures document, and other topics specific to the ASCE Greater China Student Conference Region.

Each student delegate must be a member in good standing with their student chapter and ASCE. Each student chapter in the Student Conference has one vote. At least one member of your ASCE student chapter must participate in the Business Meeting as part of the eligibility requirements to advance to finals for Concrete Canoe and Sustainable Solutions.

## **Student Symposium Paper Competition**

The ASCE Student Symposium Paper Competition emphasizes the importance of being able to write and present a paper as essential communication skills for all engineers and often necessary for advancement in your career. The competition consists of a paper submission and a presentation at the student symposium.

The topic for the 2025 ASCE Greater China Student Symposium Paper Competition is:Daniel W. Mead Prize for Students Topic.

Considering ethics, what role do civil engineers play in the prevention and response to an infrastructure disaster? Should an infrastructure disaster rouse civil engineers globally to advocate for more resilient protections for built infrastructure from climate-driven and/or man-made disasters?

Consider the Francis Scott Key Bridge Collapse in Maryland, the Interstate 95 Collapse in Pennsylvania, or other infrastructure disasters. Civil engineers are responsible for planning, designing, constructing, maintaining, and operating infrastructure while protecting and advancing the health, safety, and welfare of the public. Following large infrastructure disasters, civil engineers are often placed in the public spotlight to respond and assess the cause of the disaster and how to prevent future similar events.

### \*\*\*\*\*SOCIETY-WIDE FINALS ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT\*\*\*\*

Both the paper submission and the presentation are mandatory for any ASCE Student Chapter participating in the 2025 ASCE Greater China Student Symposium that wishes to be <u>eligible to advance to ASCE Society-wide competition finals</u>. Competitions <u>requiring</u> participation include:

- ASCE Concrete Canoe Competition
- ASCE Sustainable Solutions Competition

Note: Any papers/presentations created for any other competition do not count as an entry into the Student Symposium Paper Competition.





## **ASCE Society Competition Eligibility Requirements**

Competitions that advance to an ASCE Society-wide Competition Finals include the ASCE Concrete Canoe Competition, ASCE Sustainable Solutions Competition, and ASCE UESI Surveying Competition. The AISC/ASCE Student Steel Bridge Competition advances to the SSBC National Finals and follows the eligibility requirements below. See SSBC Rules for more information.

The purpose of student competitions is to provide student members career-enrichment opportunities to gain hands-on, practical experience and leadership skills. Society Competitions are an important and special opportunity to showcase the engineering and professional skills of student teams. As such, mutual respect is required for all stakeholders, including competitors, judges, hosts, and guests. Invitations to the Student Symposia and the ASCE Student Civil Engineering Championships/Society-wide Competition Finals are a privilege, not a right. Failure to act professionally can result in sanctions, disqualifications, and loss of invitations. Please note that the requirements for eligibility for Society-wide competition finals are more stringent than the requirements for participation at the student symposia competitions.

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR STUDENT SYMPOSIUM COMPETITION**

The following qualifications are required of all ASCE Student Chapters to compete at the Student Symposia Competitions:

#### An ASCE Student Chapter must:

- 1. Be in good standing with ASCE:
  - a. Have paid their annual dues, as received by ASCE, **no later than the start of their Student Symposium**. b. Have submitted their student chapter's full Annual Report or EZ Annual Reporting Form **no later than February 1**, **11:59 p.m. EST**.

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR ASCE SOCIETY-WIDE COMPETITION FINALS**

The following qualifications are required of all ASCE Student Chapters in order to advance to the ASCE Society-wide Competition Finals:

#### An ASCE Student Chapter must:

- 1. Be in good standing with ASCE:
  - a. Have paid their annual dues, as received by ASCE, no later than February 1, 11:59 p.m. EST.
  - b. Have submitted their student chapter's <u>full Annual Report</u>, no later than February 1, 11:59 p.m. EST, <u>and have received a minimum score of 25 points out of a possible 100.</u> Student Chapters that submit an EZ annual reporting form do not qualify to advance to competition finals; and
- 2. Attend and participate in their assigned Student Symposium as shown through their school's:
  - a. On-time attendance and active participation by a member of the ASCE Student Chapter at the Student Symposium Business Meeting.
  - b. Participation in the Student Symposium Paper Competition, including submission and presentation by a member of the ASCE Student Chapter. Note that any papers/presentations created for any other competition do not count as an entry into the Student Symposium Paper Competition.
