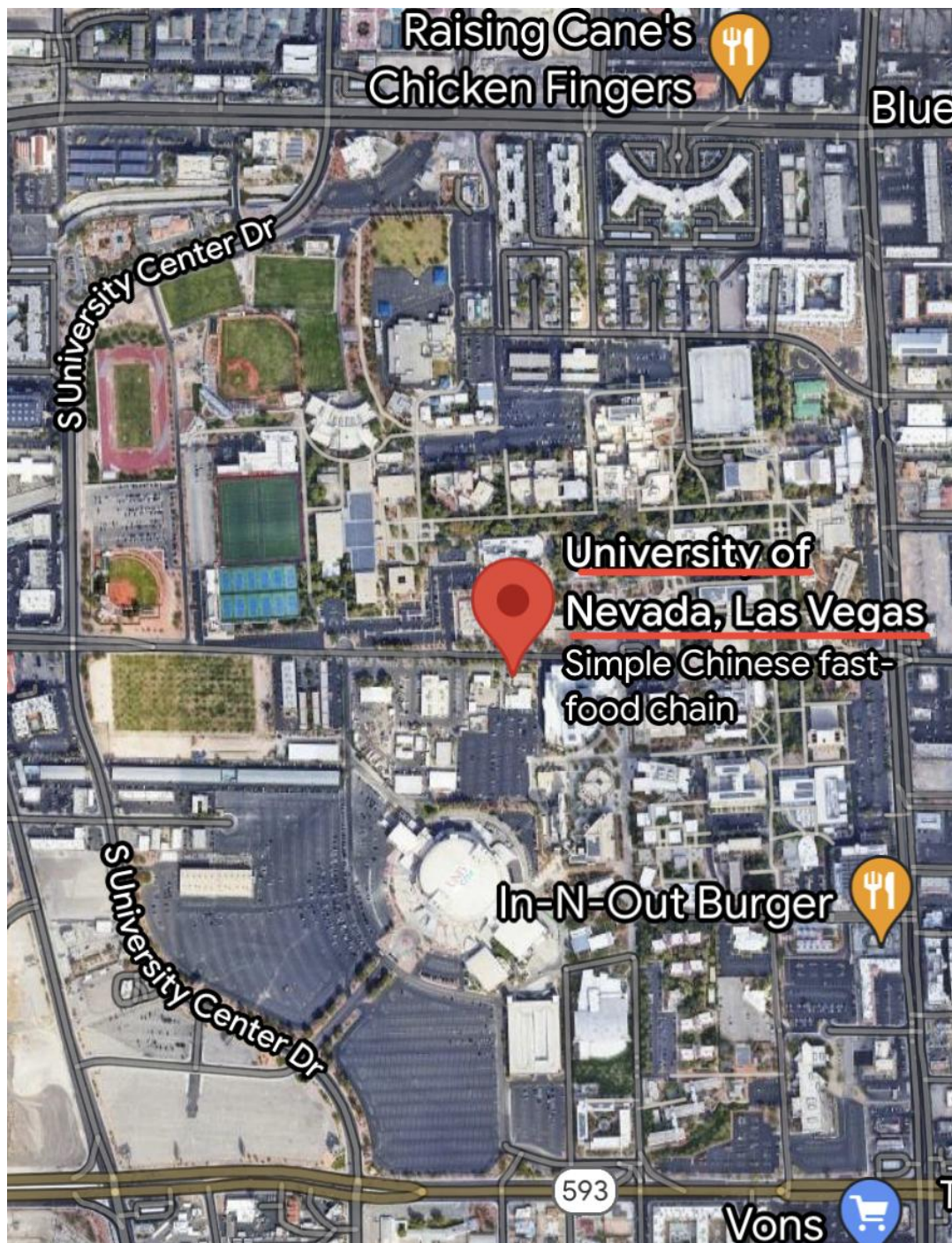

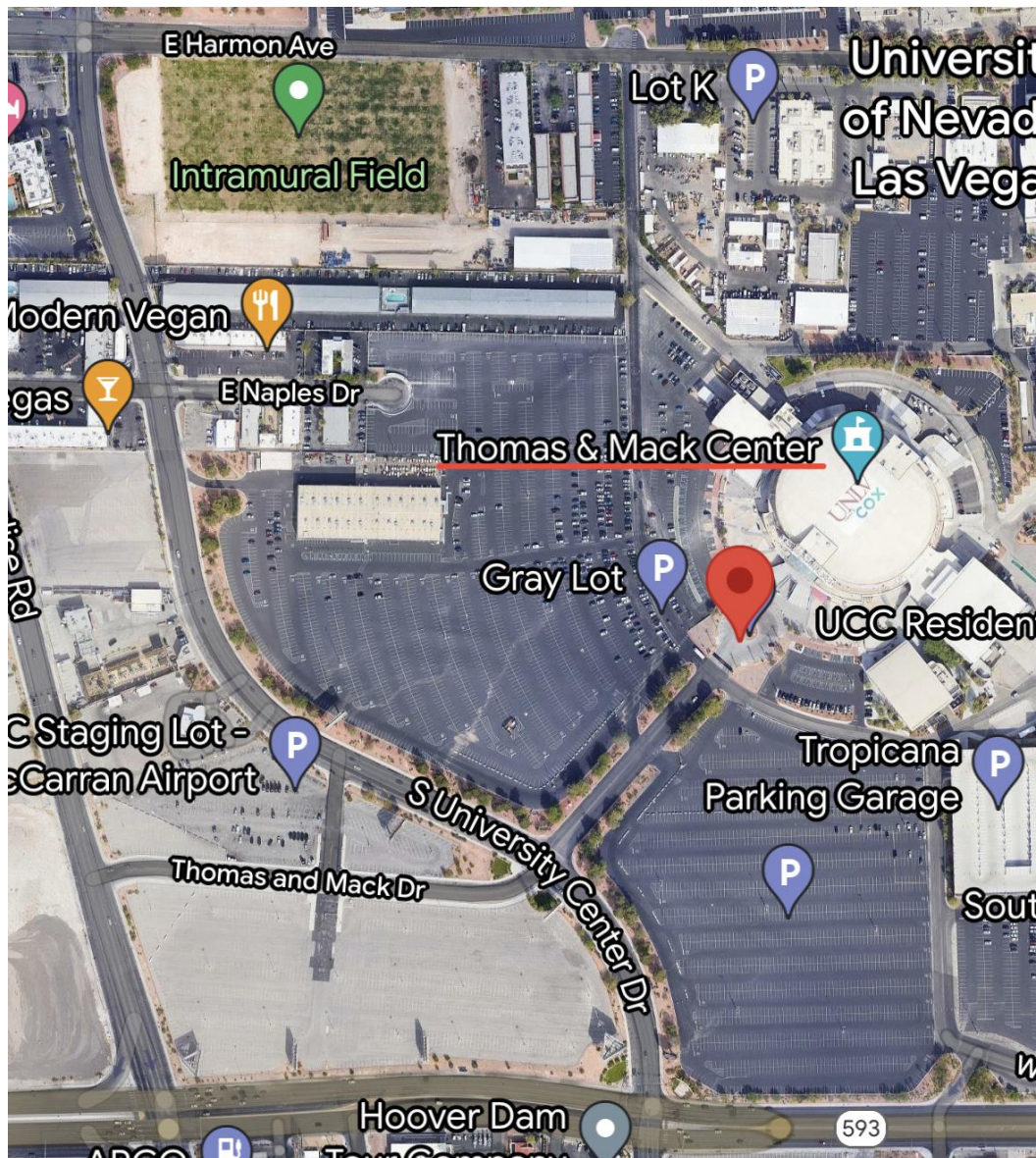

University of Nevada, Las Vegas General Map-



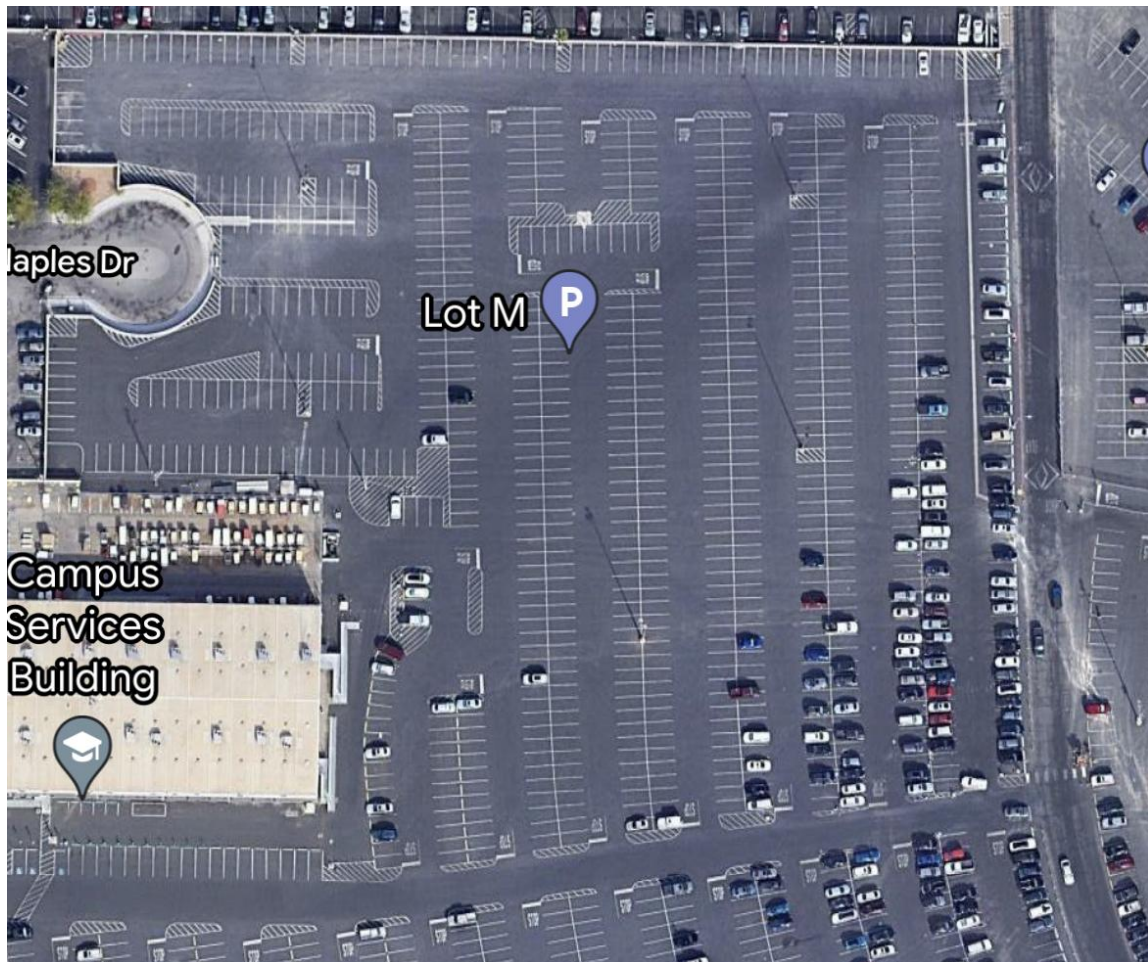
Thomas and Mack General Map -

* Schools will enter through S University Center drive towards Thomas and Mack *



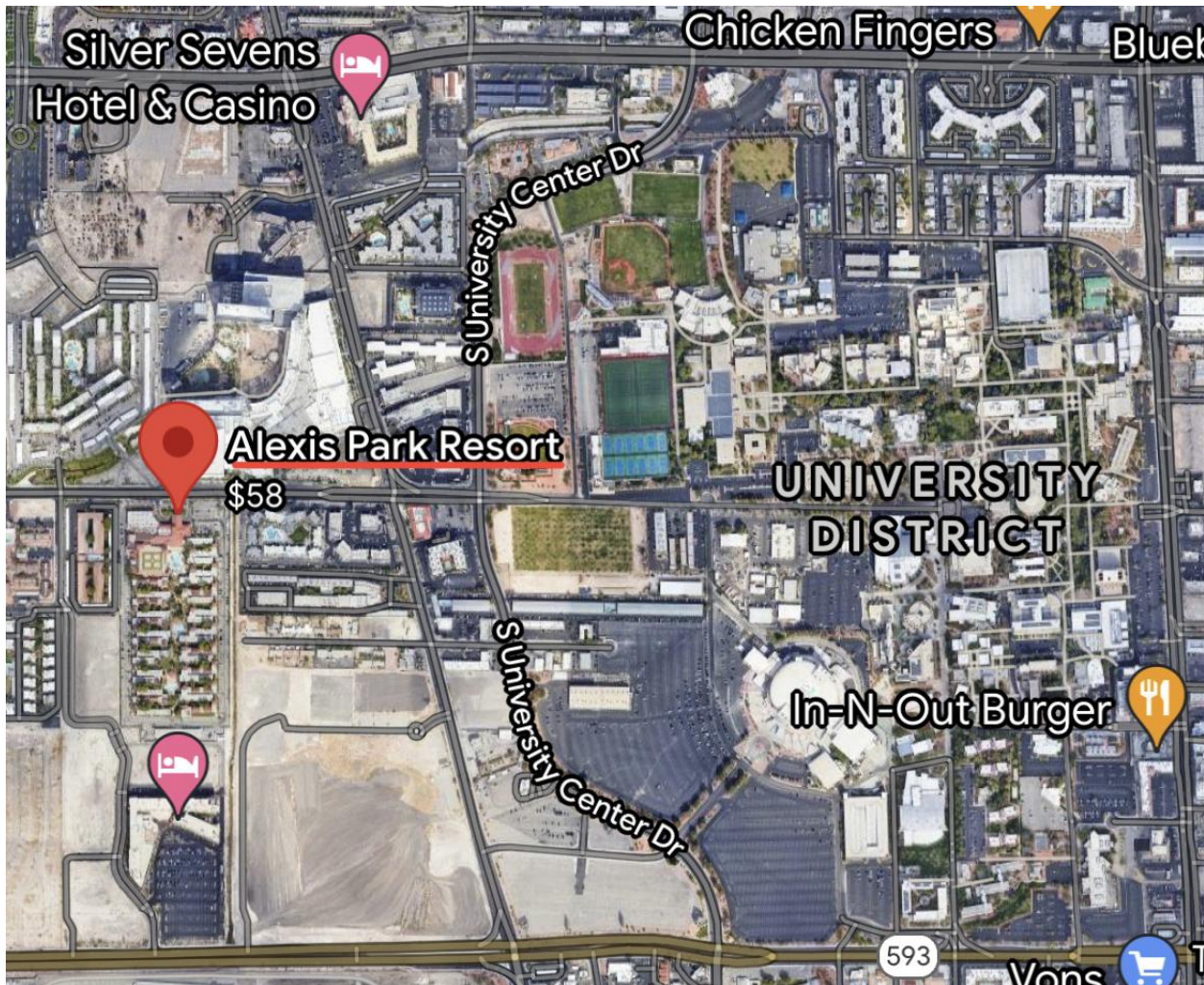
Thomas and Mack Naple Parking Lot -

* Schools will check in & park their trailers in this lot. This lot space will also be used for certain competitions (a more detailed layout of this space will be provided in Mailer III) *



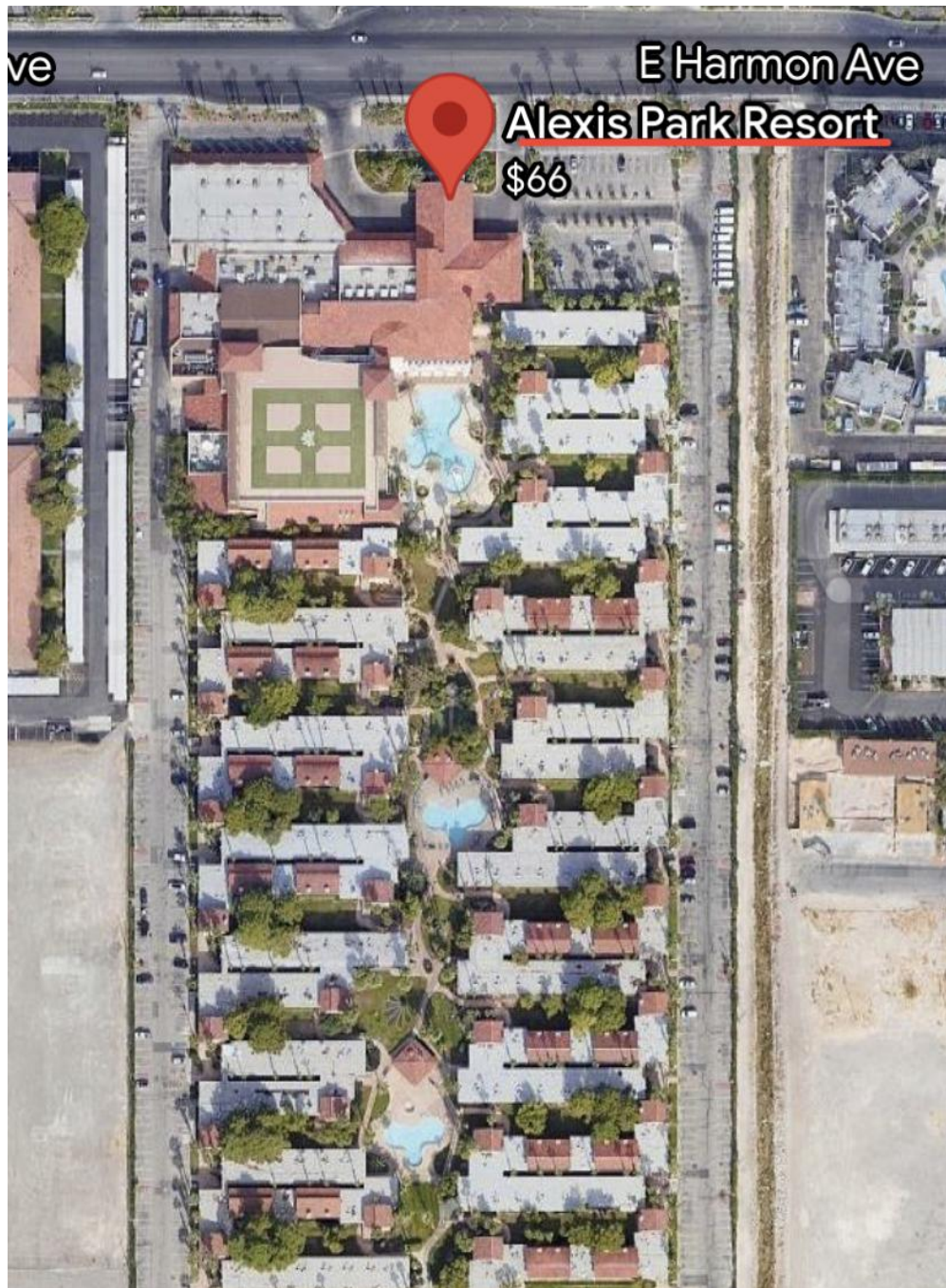
Recommended Hotel General Map -
