Intermountain Southwest Student Symposium



The Intermountain Southwest is a subregion within ASCE Region 8, which encompasses Utah, Idaho, Arizona, Nevada, Oregon, Washington, Montana, Alaska, Hawaii, and portions of Canada. Region 8 hosts two student symposiums, one of which is the Intermountain Southwest Student Symposium (ISWS). Winners of the competitions will have the opportunity to move on and compete at the ASCE Civil Engineering Student Championships.

Sustainability & Service

Our student chapter is honored to host the ASCE Intermountain Southwest Student Symposium, an exciting and rare opportunity that occurs only once every ten years. Rather than simply highlighting engineering talent, the vision for this event centers on innovation, sustainability, and community impact. As future engineers, we share a responsibility to lead by example, making sustainability a cornerstone of the planning process. Efforts include minimizing waste by reducing single-use items, providing accessible water stations, and ensuring the availability of trash and recycling bins throughout the venue. To further reduce our environmental footprint, we encourage attendees to use public transit and shared transportation options. Beyond environmental initiatives, service and outreach are also key priorities. We are actively incorporating K–12 engagement to inspire young students and spark interest in STEM. Giving back to the local community is another central focus, with planned donation drives and collaboration with organizations such as Habitat for Humanity to repurpose leftover materials. Additionally, we are coordinating with other student chapters to repurpose Timber-Strong and Concrete Canoe materials. Through the integration of technical excellence and responsible stewardship, this symposium aims to serve not only as a celebration of engineering but also as a model for meaningful and lasting impact.
