#### COVID-19 Protocols

Making the Symposium as safe as possible for all participants is a key goal as part of our plan to host a fun and engaging in-person event. In accordance with British Columbia Provincial Health Orders, all participants must provide proof of full vaccination to attend the Symposium; a list of COVID-19 vaccines approved by Health Canada is available <u>here</u>.

Additionally, all persons entering Canada must be fully vaccinated to be exempt from 14-day quarantine as per Canadian travel regulations. All travellers must download the ArriveCAN app and enter the required information prior to crossing the border. For further information, please see <u>here</u>.
