Portland State University and the University of Portland are excited to co-host the upcoming 2025 <u>ASCE Pacific Northwest Student Symposium</u>. In advance of a formal Mailer I later this year, we would like to send some preliminary information so that you can hit the ground running when your chapter reconvenes after the summer break.

The Symposium will be held the evening of **Thursday, April 3**rd, through the evening of **Saturday, April 5**th, **2025**.

We plan on offering the following student competitions:

- Student Symposium Paper (participation is required for eligibility in society-wide competitions)
- Concrete Canoe
- Steel Bridge
- Timber-Strong
- Sustainable Solutions
- Surveying
- Environmental (not society-wide competition)

We are also looking into adding some smaller competitions, such as a concrete bocce/discus/bowling ball, trivia, or casual sporting event (e.g. volleyball, disc golf). All events will take place on the Portland State University campus, except for the canoe races (and potentially the casual sporting event).

Chapters are strongly encouraged to reserve hotel accommodation as early as feasible. Lodging close to the Portland State University campus is limited, but the <u>University Place Hotel</u> (310 SW Lincoln St, Portland, OR 97201) is an ideal option, as it is minutes from the competition venues on campus and has the ability to accommodate oversized vehicles. <u>TravelPortland</u> also publishes a guide to lodging/accommodations.
