Dear ASCE Pacific Southwest Student Chapters:

This is Mailer II of PSWS, the second of three packets to be sent to each of the participating Student Chapters in our Student Conference. While we fully intend for our 2022 Student Symposium to be held in person, given the unpredictability of COVID-19 variants, it is conceivable that circumstances may change. We are trying to remain flexible in our planning and recommend that you do the same. Our Student Symposium Planning Committee and ASCE will continue to monitor the situation and provide more guidance as necessary.

Further, all individuals planning and/or participating in the student symposium are responsible for complying with all campus protocols and procedures including but not limited to COVID-19 guidelines related to in-person meetings, masking, social distancing, etc., at all times in connection with planning, preparation, or participation in the student symposium. Currently, UC San Diego requires all students and visitors to our campus to be fully-vaccinated or have a negative COVID-19 test result within the last 48 hours. This means that PSWS 2022 attendees must upload proof of their vaccination for Individual Student Registration or test negative within 48 hours of our Symposium. Please use all of the tools available to keep people safe and healthy.

Your Student Chapter should have received an email outlining information regarding hotels and parking for PSWS 2022. For your convenience, it is pasted below.

For hotels:

Our Planning Committee has been contacting hotels near UC San Diego to see if we can negotiate a discounted rate for PSWS 2022 participants. We've learned that many of the hotels would require a signed contract guaranteeing a certain block of rooms to be booked. Because we are unsure of the actual number of participants for our Symposium, we are unable to sign any contracts because our Student Chapter would be liable if we fail to fill the number of rooms. We encourage each Student Chapter to contact hotels (please use the hotels spreadsheet included in Mailer I) to negotiate discounted rates for room blocks. Please also consider public transportation during your trips to and from our campus in order to reduce the amount of traffic and need for personal vehicle parking (more information below). There are several busses that service to and from our campus to La Jolla and San Diego; I've also attached a map of our trolley system below (the Blue Line takes you to our central campus). All public transportation use the PRONTO service: <https://www.ridepronto.com/help/#pronto-app>.

For parking:

Parking at UC San Diego is not plentiful and availability varies significantly day-to-day. The Transportation Department here only allows us to reserve a limited number of spots at an expensive rate per day per vehicle. Additionally, our University's freshman admission day (Triton Day) occurs on Day 3 of our Symposium (April 2, 2022). The University expects a large influx of visitors on and close to this date, which means parking will be more scarce during our Symposium. For these reasons, we are unable to provide reserved parking spots for PSWS attendees but will instead be giving details on the parking structures on our campus so that attendees may find and pay for their own parking. To reduce the amount of traffic going to and from our campus during the Symposium dates, we highly encourage your schools' attendees to carpool and use the Blue Line Trolley for transportation as much as possible.

1) Individual Student Registration Instructions

Each Student Chapter is required to register all PSWS 2022 participants from their University and submit **ONE** Student Registration payment on behalf of all individual student attendees from their respective University. We encourage all Student Chapters to register their students within the Early-Bird Registration time-frame; the Regular Registration time-frame is a chance for last-minute individuals to register if they want to attend PSWS 2022. If your Student Chapter has registrants for both Early-Bird and Regular Registration deadlines, you may submit one Student Registration payment for each registration type (total of TWO Student Registration payments).

Please note that we must receive payment in full as well as all necessary individual participant information in order to process your students' registrations.

a) Individual Student Registration fee

- For *Early-Bird Registration* (February 13, 2022 deadline): \$125 per student
- For *Regular Registration* (March 6, 2022 deadline): \$175 per student

The Student Registration fee includes for each student:

- Eligibility to attend the ASCE Pacific Southwest Symposium 2022 and compete in Technical & Non-Technical Competitions
- Lunch for all three days of Symposium
- A Symposium merch bundle, which includes a PSWS 2022 t-shirt, lanyard & name-tag, visor, and stickers
- Entry to and dinner at the Awards Banquet

b) Required Individual Participant Information

To help you register students from your Chapter, please use the following PSWS 2022 Individual Student Registration TEMPLATE: <https://forms.gle/Unj7oz4kXoRgtX7d6>. This Google Form provides a template for you to use; please do not submit responses as any responses will not be considered.

In order for us to process your university's individual student registrations, we must receive the following by February 13, 2022 for Early-Bird Registration:

1. ONE spreadsheet (or link to spreadsheet) sent to psws2022@gmail.com with complete responses to your university's copy of this form, and
2. ONE check sent to the SCSE mailing address accounting for all individual students attending PSWS 2022 from your Chapter.

If your Student Chapter has registrants for the Regular Deadline, please submit a separate spreadsheet with complete responses to your own copy of this form as well as separate payment by March 6, 2022.

*Important notes:

- 1.) It is imperative that your check payment corresponds to the correct number of responses in the spreadsheet. For example, if your Student Chapter is registering 100 students in the Early-Bird time-frame, then the check payment should be $[100 \times \$125 =] \$12,500$ and the spreadsheet should have exactly 100 responses.
- 2.) When sending the spreadsheet/link to psws2022@gmail.com, please make sure we are able to access the spreadsheet/link AND the pdf attachments for resumes, waivers, and COVID-19 vaccination cards/statements. Please name your spreadsheet using this convention: YourUniversity_Individual_Student_Registration_Responses.




