1 Introduction

March 10, 2022

Dear ASCE Pacific Southwest Student Chapters:

This is Mailer III of PSWS, the final of three packets to be sent to each of the participating Student Chapters in our Student Conference. As of the date on this letter, we fully intend for our 2022 Student Symposium to be held in person. We have not received any updates that indicate PSWS 2022 will be anything other than an in-person conference. Should there be any last-minute deviations, we will notify all Student Chapter immediately. During this home-stretch of our planning process, we are extremely excited to be hosting the first in-person ASCE Pacific Southwest Symposium in two years as well as the first one that UC San Diego has hosted in 15 years!

As stated in previous Mailers, all individuals participating in the student symposium are responsible for complying with all campus protocols and procedures including but not limited to COVID-19 guidelines related to in-person meetings, masking, social distancing, etc., at all times in connection with planning, preparation, or participation in the student symposium. Currently, UC San Diego requires all students and visitors to our campus to be fully-vaccinated or have a negative COVID-19 test result within the last 48 hours. This means that PSWS 2022 attendees show either 1) proof of their vaccination or 2) a negative COVID-19 test result within 48 hours of our Symposium. We do not want to turn anyone away because they cannot provide either of these items, but we must comply with our University policies. Please use all of the tools available to keep people safe and healthy.

Parking and Transportation



Parking:

As mentioned in Mailer II and previous emails, parking at UC San Diego is not plentiful and availability varies significantly day-to-day. The Transportation Department here only allows us to reserve a limited number of spots at an expensive rate per day per vehicle. Additionally, our University's freshman admission day (Triton Day) occurs on Day 3 of our Symposium (April 2, 2022). The University expects a large influx of visitors on and close to this date, which means parking will be more scarce during our Symposium. For these reasons, we are unable to provide reserved parking spots for PSWS attendees but will instead be giving details on the parking structures on our campus so that attendees may find and pay for their own parking.

Our Transportation department suggests the following parking structures/lots as they have relatively more visitor (designated "V" spots) parking spots:

- Gilman Parking Structure
- Osler Parking Structure
- Pangea Parking Structure
- Gliderport Parking Lot (furthest from main campus)



Public Transportation:

Depending on the hotel that your Student Chapter is staying in, it may more convenient to use public transportation to get to and from our campus. This will also help to reduce the amount of traffic going to and from our campus during the Symposium dates. We highly encourage your schools' attendees to carpool and use the Blue Line Trolley/public transportation for transportation as much as possible. There are many bus routes to and from UC San Diego, so please use smart-navigation to determine the quickest route for your school.





Maps: Concrete Canoe Display

Please note that we have not reserved these parking lots, so they're for temporary unloading/loading only to avoid traffic jams.








Maps: De Anza Cove Waters and Park
