Impromptu

1. Objective

To give students an opportunity to learn teamwork, leadership, and strategy outside of the academic setting, as well as build Chapter pride with friendly competition.

2. Event Description

This tournament can be given the title of “Back to back drawing,” where participants from schools will compete in accurately drawing the provided prompt.

3. Participant Rules

- Each school may only enter one team.
- Each team must consist of 4 members (substitutions are allowed between rounds).
- Each team member must be a registered participant of PSWS 2023.
- Each team must have at least one underclassman.
- Each team must have at least one identifying female playing at all times.
- Failure in meeting these requirements will result in an automatic forfeit.

4. Dress Code

- Come wearing **clothes** and your PSWS Badge.

5. General Rules

1. The California State University, Northridge does not take responsibility for injuries that are related to activities.
2. All rule interpretation and any disputes not explicitly stated in the rules will be left to the officials.

Structure

3. 2 teams will compete in a simultaneous game of “Back to back drawing”, where all members are standing in a straight line, front to back. Each person will be given a piece of paper and a marker.
4. The person in the back; the player that does not have another player behind them, will be given a random word and will draw it on the player in front of them. They are not allowed to speak about it to their partners.
5. The teams will be given 5 minutes to brief and set up, 10 minutes in total for all of the players to finish their drawings, and 10 minutes for judging. Each game/round will last about 25 minutes.
6. Each school is allowed one vote and can not vote for its team. The participating schools are also not allowed to vote in that round. The schools will vote for the drawing that matches the closest to the word.
7. The first team with the most points will win the game, and subsequent games will follow the elimination bracket and schedule.
