COMPETITIONS



Students are tasked with creating a durable, lightweight concrete mix to design and construct a fully functional concrete canoe. It is showcased through a professional presentation and a series of canoe races against other university competition chapters.



Teams are challenged to design and build a scale-model steel bridge spanning approximately 20 feet and capable of supporting a 2,500-pound load. Bridges are assembled onsite during timed construction, and evaluated based on structural efficiency, durability, and aesthetics.

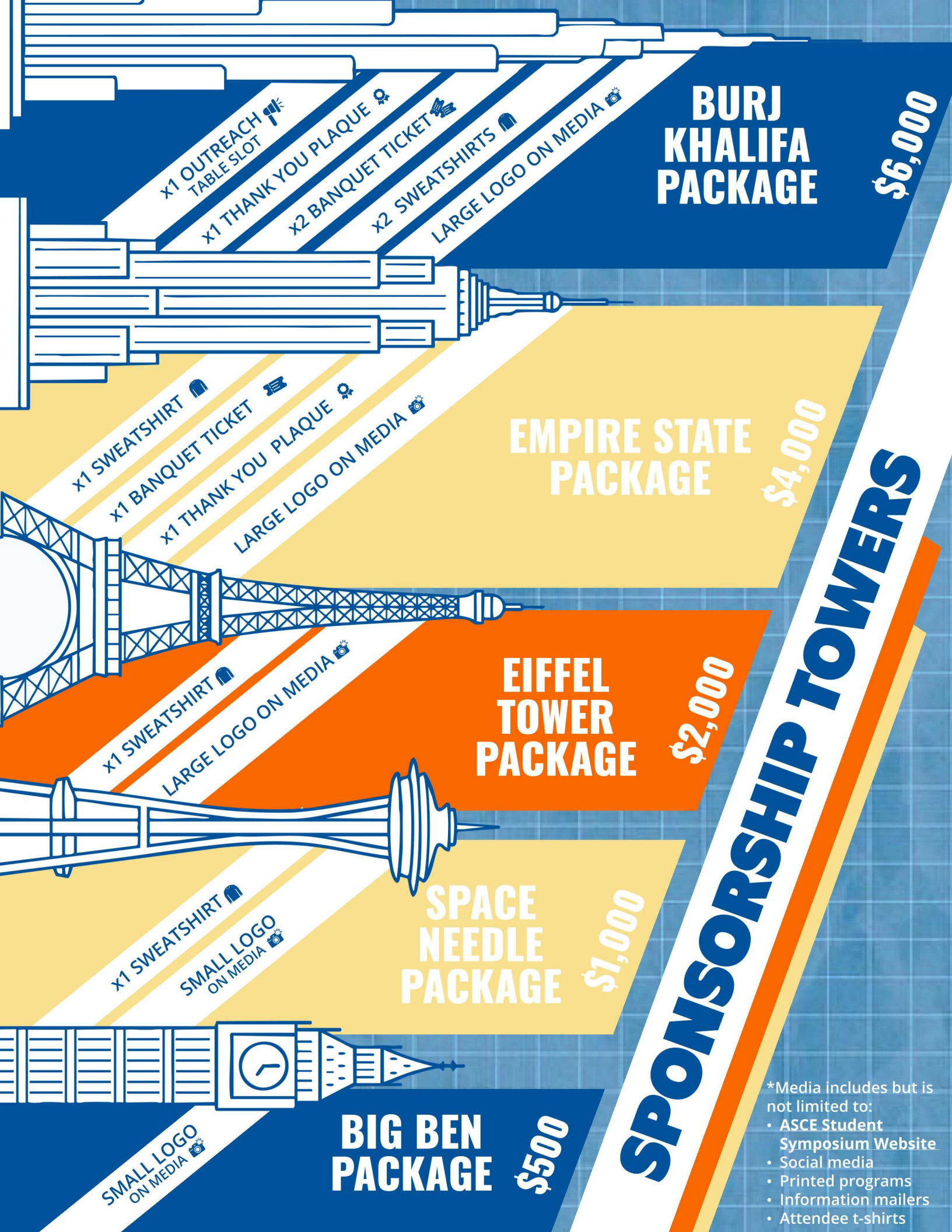


Participants tackle a real-world issue by applying sustainability principles in engineering to respond to a request for proposal. Teams are encouraged to think creatively, leverage available resources, and use engineering judgment to find innovative solutions to everyday problems.



Teams test their expertise in land surveying through five tasks: topographic mapping, pacing, differential leveling, building stakeout, and determining sewer line depth. It highlights the importance of fundamental surveying principles in civil engineering.

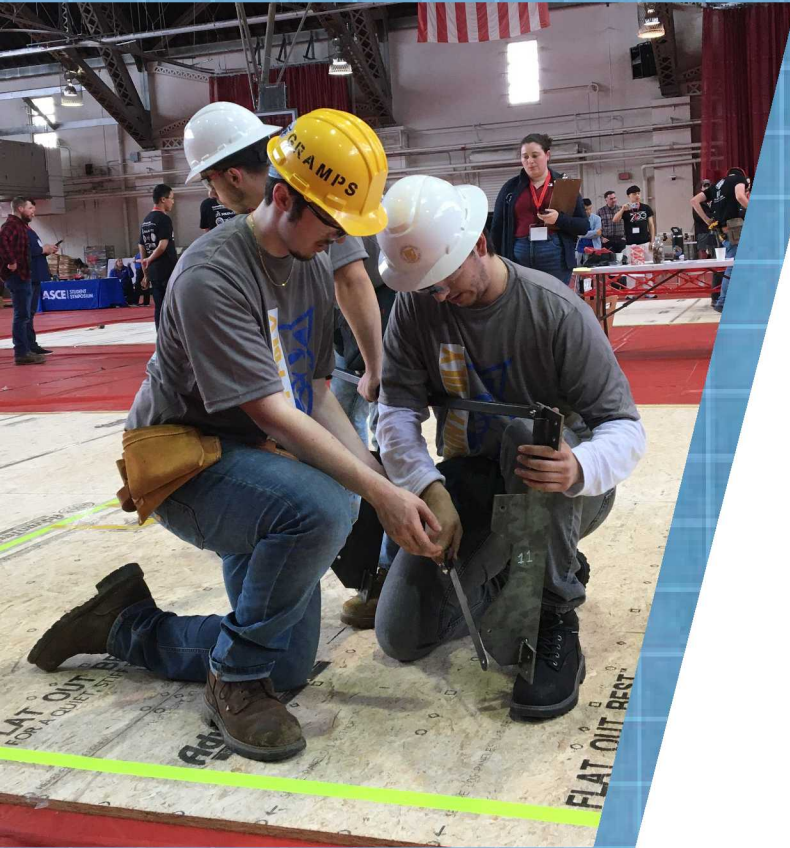
