- ❖ Teams competing in AISC/ASCE Student Steel Bridge, ASCE Sustainable Solutions and ASCE UESI Surveying must submit an online [Intent and Eligibility Acknowledgement Form](#) for no later than November 1, 2024, by 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time (ET).
 - Each competition requires its own form to be filled out. One entry does not cover all 3 competitions
 - Form must be completed separately by each entity; team captain, ASCE Student Chapter Faculty Advisor, and Competition Faculty Advisor, if applicable.

Besides the main competitions, smaller competitions and sporting events like concrete cornhole and volleyball will be available throughout the symposium. Updates about rules and locations for these smaller competitions and sporting events will be available on [WGL Symposium website](#). All events will either take place at the university campuses or the concrete canoe race location.

Student Chapters should reserve hotel accommodations as early as possible. Go to <https://www.visitmilwaukee.org/> to find the hotel that is best for your student chapter. Hotel selections should be close to the three university campuses for fast travel to competitions and events.
